

Keeper's Place

Sam and Nana met with council planners to discuss the traffic issues caused by the projected Keeper's Place proposal. The council advised highlighting the importance of linking all MK East sites, and approaching the four developers involved in MK East - Berkeley Homes, Bloor Homes, Hallam Land Management, and Gallagher Developments, to see if they will work together to build an access road into the west of Keepers Place.

Thanks to residents' support, the petition has over 800 signatures and will be presented to the council by Wing in January. In total, our petition has caught the attention of local and national media outlets in Milton Keynes, Express, MSN, and multiple social media community pages. Help us reach 1,000 by 21 January 2026.
