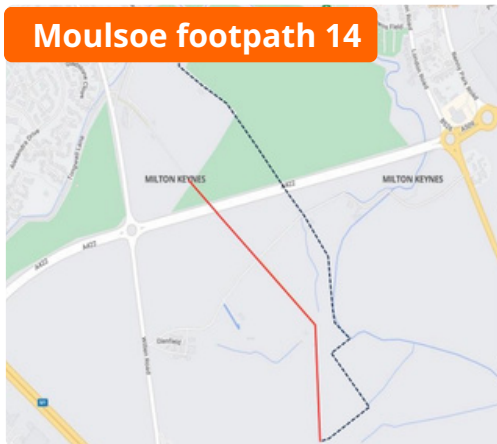

Bloor Homes has applied to the Council's Rights of Way team to divert Moulsoe Public Footpath 14. The proposed new route is part of the Bloor Homes site within the wider MK East development.

The diversion is needed to allow the development to go ahead while still providing a suitable public footpath through the area. The Council is inviting residents to share any comments or concerns about the proposed change.
