Good news for MK East. Moulsoe Parish Council will take care of the first new homes in Newport Vale and Elverby, with extra funding and support from MK Council.



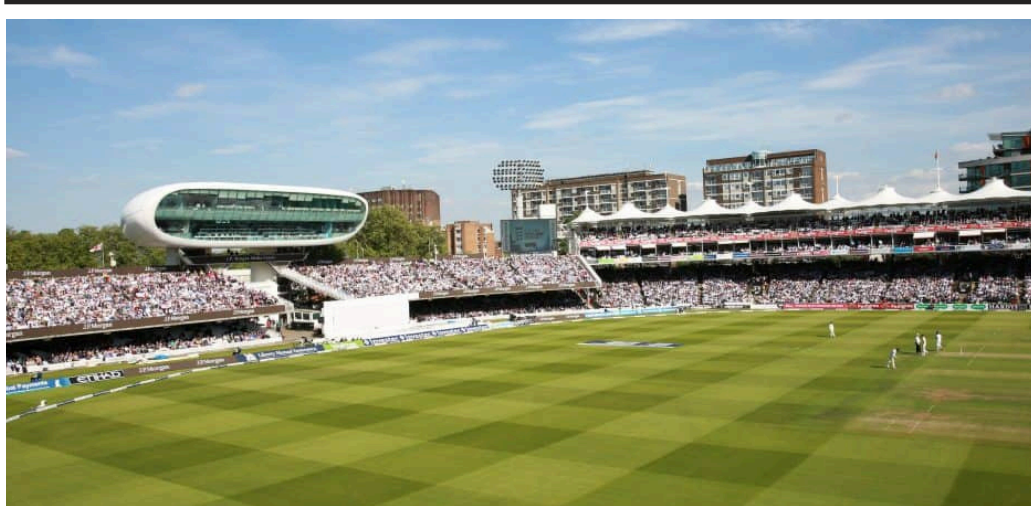
THE BBC CAME TO COVER THE A509 OPENING

THAMES VALLEY POLICE COMMUNITY FORUM
