Norovirus Peaks

The Norovirus is peaking in the UK at present, causing sickness and diarrhea, headaches, body and tummy aches and pains, and putting many vulnerable people into hospital.

It transmits very easily by air or touch, so please take basic precautions - keep a little distance from others if possible, clean toilet seats, basins, bathroom door handles etc. frequently, and wash your hands frequently in soap and water - gel-based cleansers do NOT work against Norovirus.

If you get it, please isolate yourself from others as far as you can until 2 days after the symptoms stop.

Council Budget

The Labour Council forced through their budget, rejecting most amendments. Council tax will rise by 4.99% including 2% for Adult Social Care. Other authorities such



as the Police and Fire Authority are raising their precepts higher, so you'll see a bigger increase in your bills in the coming year. A Lib Dem amendment to provide more help for parish councils wanting to make flood response plans, which unlock government aid, was accepted.

The Council acted swiftly when **Duncan** and the Parish Warden reported a damaged drain on **Fyfield Barrow** leading to **Walnut Tree**. The manhole had a 3 ft drop below it! The surround and manhole were repaired the next day.

V11 Roundabouts

Following the consultation last autumn, the Council is going ahead with signalising Brinklow roundabout (V11/H8) over Easter. They will also be going ahead with the "hamburger" option for Monkston roundabout - V11/H7 with prep work over next winter and main work starting in spring 2026.

Walton Manor Plans

Detailed plans for the 174 homes at Walton Manor are in at last so have your say - search for Planning Applications on the Council website and then for application ref PLN/2024/2763. There's little change since the outline planning application, and there will be play areas sufficient to serve the north part of Walton Park and Walton Grange as well as the new housing.



Local Councils on the Move

After many years at their base at SNAP in Walnut Tree, Walton Community Council will move to new offices at the OU on Walton Hall in April, saving around 50% of their rent.

And Kents Hill and Monkston Parish Council are negotiating to take over Monkston Pavilion and playing fields from 1st April.
