Free School Meals Extended

After years of pressure from the Lib Dems, free school meals will now be available for all children in England whose parents get Universal Credit. It means fewer children are going to school hungry and families under pressure will have one less thing to worry about. "Noone should have to go hungry so that their child can eat - and no child should be distracted from learning by hunger. I'm proud that we've made that happen" said **Uroy Clarke**.

Is your Underpass Lit?

Jenni has asked them to remove orange fencing from near The Newmanry and Cyber Avenue, Oakgrove.



Lighting Up H7



Jenni got the Council to fix many of the faulty lights on the H7 Chaffron Way - but a few are still out near Flaxley Gate, Monkston so she has reported them again.

Lorries Only!

Jenni has got the fallen post removed from beside the loading bay for the shops off Ada Walk, Oakgrove. She's asked for it to be replaced to stop shoppers parking there.

Please don't park there as it forces lorries to block the street, and block your car in.



Fixing Lucas Place

Macsene has reported the pothole at the entrance to Lucas Place, Woughton on the Green. Jenni has asked Orbit Housing to prune the hedges blocking the entrances.



Winter Fuel Payment Restored

Following a successful Lib Dem campaign, the Government has made a u-turn and the Winter Fuel Payment will be paid to most pensioners in England aged over 66 with taxable income less than £35,000pa. Some care home residents will be excluded. For those earning more than £35,000pa, the Government will reclaim it through their tax code or self-assessment.

The Lib Dems are now campaigning to get it backdated and paid to last year's pensioners who are eligible now.

Affordable Shared Ownership Housing

Charging a huge premium for a shared ownership home on top of the purchase price is common here - making it unaffordable. Now **Jenni** has found that this is banned for many homes! If the home was built with a government grant, there's a clause banning premiums. The Council will now work with housing associations to stop the practice and keep our shared ownership affordable for those who need it.

Blocked Drains? Or Covers?

Leaf debris blocked some drain covers leading to flooding after wet weather recently in the underpass from Monkston to Oakgrove School. Jenni has asked for it to be cleared, but if debris starts to build up, please report it to the waste service, before it floods, since the waste service clean them. Thank you.



Did you know?

When traffic lights are put in, the speed limit has to drop to 40 mph. It's because the time taken to change from green to red is set by law, and it's not long enough to stop safely at higher speeds.

Yellow Lines

Thank you to all those who responded to the consultation about double yellow lines outside MK Village pub. The response was in favour and the Parish Council will ask MK Council to install them.

In Brief

This van appears to have been abandoned on Council land in **Tyhurst**, **Middleton**. If it belongs to you, please remove it by the end of September or the Council will be asked to remove it.

Uroy has asked for these trees overhanging the bridleway near **Stanbrook Place, Monkston** to be pruned back after residents complained.

The Focus team has asked Woughton
Community Council to clear the debris from the paths behind Ambridge Grove and Waterside in Peartree Bridge.

Jenni has got a wider area of the grass cut at the entrance to the Parks Trust car park on Simpson Drive, to clear the view of oncoming traffic.

The Oakgrove School grounds crew litter picked the underpass leading to Monkston, and will pick it regularly, after Macsene requested it.

Uroy has asked the Council to safety-check this tree, leaning over Harlesden Close in Monkston Park.
