Lighting Up

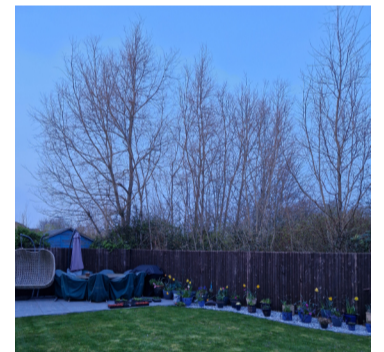

Jenni is asking the Council to finish the job started years ago to remove trees causing subsidence behind **Kilwinning Drive** and **Malton Close, Monkston**



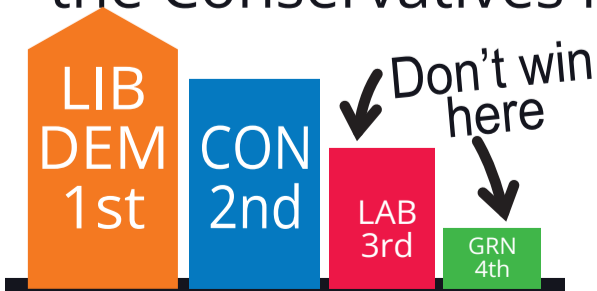

Developers rubbish, materials and equipment caused blockages on several roads on large and tiny developments. The team worked with the council to get them cleared.



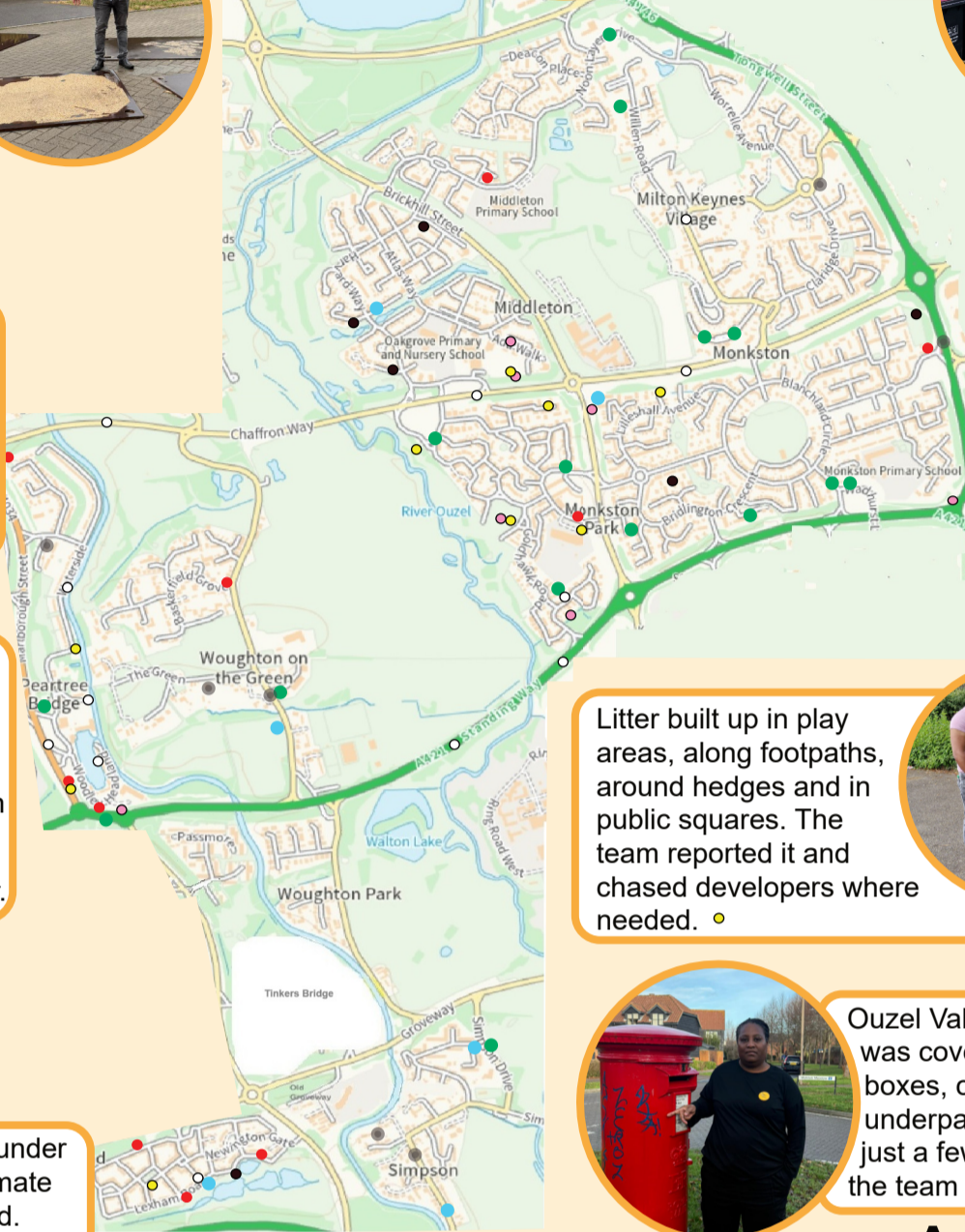
Potholes hit the headlines as the team worked to get the worst fixed.



Bin stores at flats and litter bins became a problem in several areas. Jenni and Macsene worked with the council and owners to get them cleared, reducing the rat problems.



Ouzel Valley has some of the oldest stretches of new city road. The team got lights fixed in several black spots on estates and underpasses and worked with other Lib Dems to demand more priority for those that left areas blacked out.



Our trees are beautiful - at the right size! The team got trees and hedges pruned and dead trees removed on most of our estates to stop them blocking footpaths, roads and drainage ditches.



Help to get children counselling, funding for a community diversity day, support for Willen Hospice's Help at Home service, funds towards a sensory garden at a school, and funds for the provision of basic hygiene supplies were among the things funded by our councillors ward budgets this year.

Litter built up in play areas, along footpaths, around hedges and in public squares. The team reported it and chased developers where needed.



Drains came under pressure as climate change accelerated. Jenni got several cleared, and successfully argued for work to start towards a new balancing lake to reduce the problem city-wide.

Ouzel Valley suffered as the city was covered in graffiti - post boxes, cabinets, street lights, underpasses and bus stops were just a few of the items damaged as the team declared war on graffiti!

Postal Votes Arrive Soon

If you applied for a postal vote by 31st March, then the vote should arrive soon after 17th April. Remember:

- You have **3 votes** this time. Please use them to elect the hard working **Lib Dem focus team**
- You can only hand in up to 5 postal votes at Polling Stations or the Civic Offices
- If you do hand your vote in, you'll need to fill in a form, so don't try to post it through the door.
- But you can send votes back by post, without a stamp.
